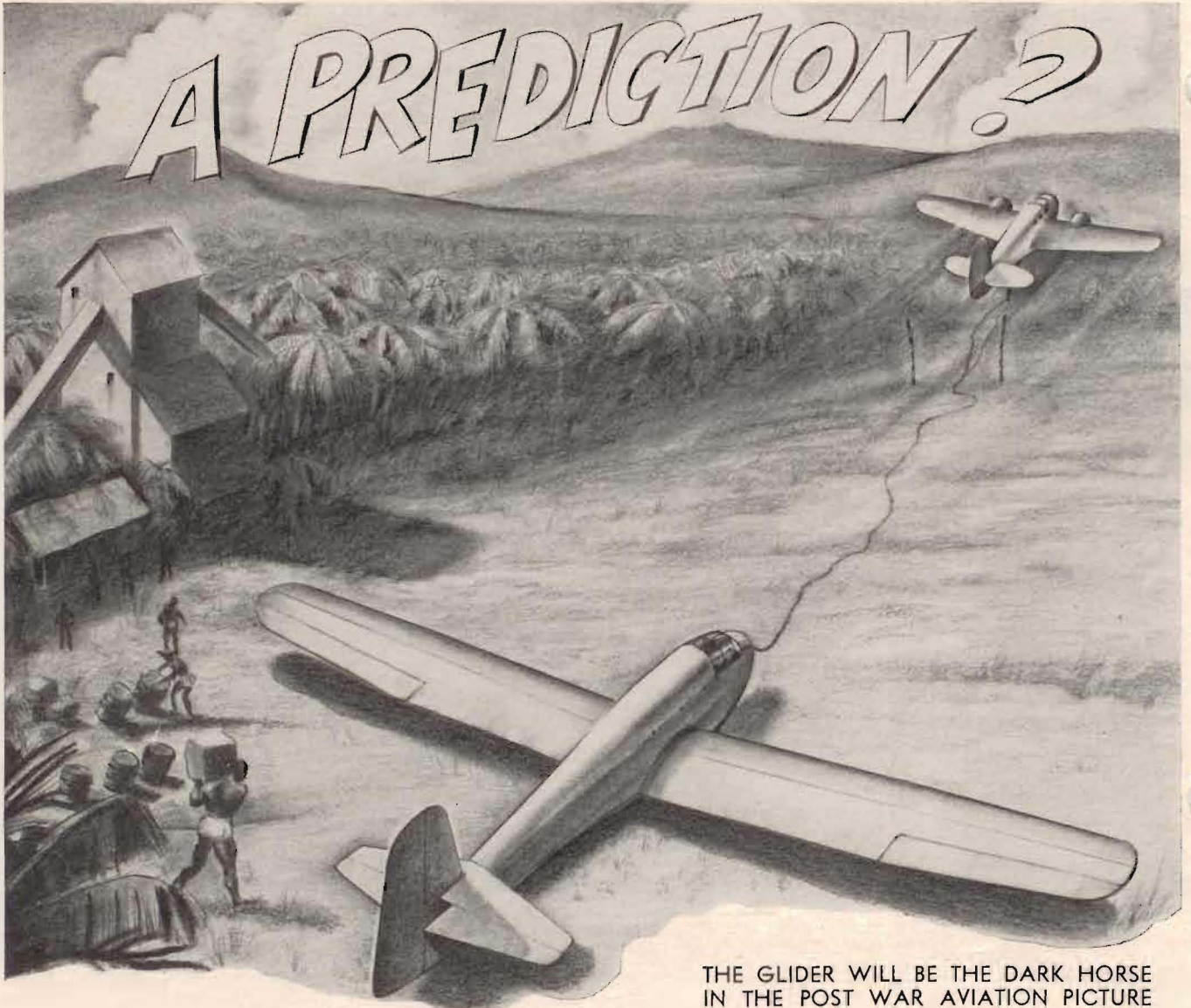


A PREDICTION?

IN THE POST WAR AVIATION PICTURE

Few people realize the potentialities of the glider. Besides its great possibilities in sport, as a trainer, and as a tactical weapon, the glider has a great future in the transportation field.
